No. 2. I was born near Malton a Borough town in Yorkshire, England, on the 3rd of January 1800, and came to P. E. Island in the year 1822, in the Barque, "Mary" Eldon, which sailed from the Port of Bristol, on Board of which, besides the Crew, were 4 I think about 60 passengers, who were used as well, as the generality of Passengers: two Welsh families were landed at the Straits of Canso, being bound for the United States, the rest came on to C. Town where they landed on the 3rd June, there were no births and only one death of a child. The state of the Island, was in general, uncultivated and presented the appearance of a Desert, a few green fields, like oases in a desert, were to be seen along the shore.
